



Earnst Leon Schuenemeyer

November 21, 1941 - January 1, 2018

Earnst Leon Schuenemeyer, son of the late Walter Earnst and Mildred Lucille (Stubblefield) Schuenemeyer, was born November 21, 1941 in Jefferson City, Missouri. He passed away Monday, January 1, 2018 in the University of Missouri Hospital and Clinics of Columbia, Missouri having attained the age of 76 years, 1 month and 11 days. In addition to his parents, Leon was preceded in death by his brother-in-law, Inmon Dale Simpson.

He grew up in Richland, graduating from Richland High School with the Class of 1959. Leon served in the United States Army from 1966 - 1968 before serving as President of Diversified Industries, of Independent Stave, Inc. of Lebanon for 30 years.

Leon was united in marriage to Ramona Jean Harris on May 5, 1973 at the First Baptist Church of Richland.
