James Lee Davis Sr., son of the late Glen Ray and Hazel Maude (Drummond) Davis, was born August 31, 1943 in Oceola, Nebraska. As a young child, James and his family moved to Reno, Nevada where he spent the majority of his childhood and early teenage years.

James entered the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his honorable discharge on May 15, 1964. After his discharge from the Army, James returned home to Reno. He spent a few years there before moving to the St. Louis area where he remained the remainder of his years until just recently. He moved to the Waynesville area to be close to his son.

James worked as a handyman and construction worker. He enjoyed working with his hands. James loved helping people out and was always extending a helping hand to his children and other people as well.
