Mathol Anne Hill, daughter of Archie and Velma (Odom) Nichols, was born May 26, 1941 in Wellston, Missouri. She went home to be with her Lord Saturday, October 27, 2018 in the Life Care Center of Waynesville, Missouri having attained the age of seventy-seven years.

Anne, as she was known to her family and friends, grew up in the Dixon area and graduated from Dixon High School. At the young age of sixteen, Anne (according to her words years later) decided she needed a husband, so she married Charles Eldo Hill on October 13, 1957 in Waynesville, Missouri. They shared over sixty-one years of marriage together and were blessed with three children: Theresa, Nancy and Ronald.

Anne worked for Revlon as a make-up artist / consultant and retired after twenty-seven years of faithful service. In her spare time, she loved to go camping and travel with her family. She also enjoyed cooking for and helping others in any and every way she possibly could.

As a young girl, Anne made a profession of faith and was currently a member of the Westside Baptist Church. She was very active in the church until her health started to decline. She taught Sunday School, helped in the kitchen at church and supervised the kitchen committee for many, many years.




