Adrian Nicholas Thomson, son of the late Adrian Bill Thomason and Darlene Virginia (Barker) Thomson, was born in Colusa, California on August 4, 1949.

As a young boy, Adrian grew up in California and in 1967, at the age of 18, Adrian entered the United States Marine Corp and served his country faithfully until his honorable discharge in 1975. For his faithful service, Adrian earned several awards and commendations which included Presidential Unit Citation, Navy Unit Commendation, Rifle Marksman Badge, Vietnam Service Medal w/4, Republic of Vietnam Cross of Gallantry w/palm and Good Conduct Medal. During his time in the military, Adrian served in Vietnam from April 22, 1968 – May 12, 1969.

After his time in the military, Adrian began driving an over the road truck and did so until 2009 when his health began to decline.

On September 16, 2013, Adrian was united in marriage to Kathleen Ann Moore in Rolla, Missouri. They shared over 11 years of marriage together and many wonderful memories.

Adrian loved being with his family. He enjoyed having BBQs and pool parties for his family, and just simply treasured the times that they could spend together. Adrian enjoyed being at home doing woodworking projects, which he

gave to his family and friends.

Adrian passed away Wednesday, October 16, 2024, in his home in Dixon, Missouri having attained the age of 75 years. He will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.

He leaves to cherish his memory, his wife, Kathleen Thomson of the home in Dixon; three children, Donna Miller (Richard) of Dixon, MO, Phyllis Boggs (Tracy) of Waynesville, MO, and T.C. 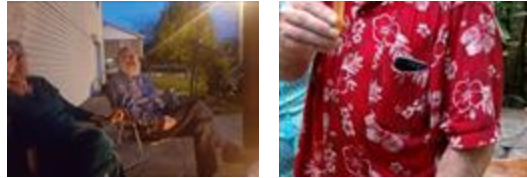
