SSG (Ret) Alfred N. Bio, son of the late Alejandro B. and Rosa Megofna (Nauta) Bio, was born July 25, 1954 in Agat, Guam where he grew up and attended school.

Fred entered the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his retirement. He had attained the rank of Staff Sergeant and received many awards and commendations. At the time of his retirement, Fred was stationed at Fort Leonard Wood and decided to remain in the area after retiring.

One of Fred's duty stations was in Korea and while there he met Yong Sun Lee. They were united in marriage on August 23, 1982 in Seoul and they were blessed with four children: Diana Rose, Donna, Dominic and Destiny.

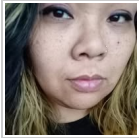

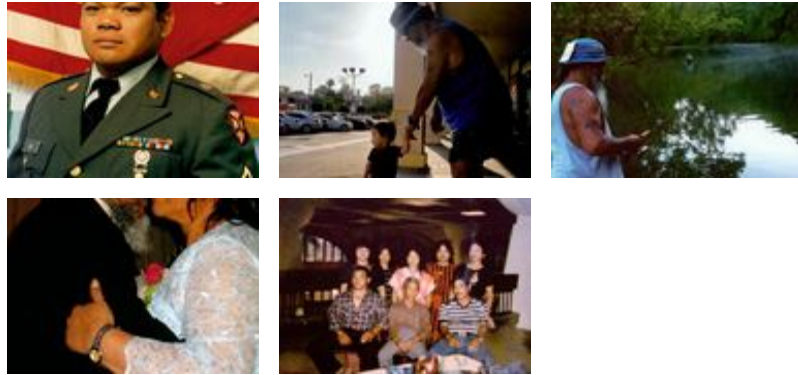
