Alice Olemberio McElroy, daughter of Felix Olemberio and Agripina Sacal Olemberio, was born May 27, 1938 in Calamba, Misamis Occidental, Philippines where she grew up and attended school.

A World War II survivor, she continued to work no matter what the situation was. Her drive was an inspiration to all of the family.

On May 15, 1978, Alice was united in marriage to Donald Matthew McElroy on Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. They shared over 39 years of marriage together and many wonderful memories before he preceded her in death on July 11, 2017.

Alice was a hardworking woman and took great pride in helping to provide for her family. After coming to the States and Fort Leonard Wood, she began working on post in food service at the hospital and her latest employment was at Burger King on Fort Leonard Wood.

Alice passed away Wednesday, September 13, 2017 in the Life Care Center of Waynesville, Missouri with her daughter by her side, after a short and courageous battle with cancer. She had attained the age of 79 years, 3 months and 17 days.

Alice will be sadly missed but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved her. She leaves to cherish her memory, three sons: Michael McElroy of Buckhorn, MO, David McElroy of Waynesville, MO and Noel Ray McElroy of Vernon Hills, IL; one daughter: Laura Schadewaldt of North Port, FL; nine grandchildren; five great grandchildren; several brothers, sisters, nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
