



## Alice Falkenrath Wells

December 18, 1915 - August 15, 2013

Alice Falkenrath Wells, age 97, long-time resident of Devil's Elbow, Missouri, died Thursday, August 15th at the Mayo Clinic in Sparta, Wisconsin.

Alice was born December 18, 1915 to Fred and Grace Falkenrath in St Louis, Missouri. She married Clyde Raymond Wells on April 27, 1935 in Rolla, Missouri. She worked as an LPN in the Waynesville Missouri area for many years. She retired from civil service as an LPN at Fort Leonard Wood Army Hospital.

Alice and her husband Raymond became well known locally for their oak basket-making. After retiring, they spent their summers together fishing on the Big Piney and Gasconade Rivers, and spent the winter months making beautiful quilts. Alice loved to knit and crochet and made many beautiful items for her family and friends. She loved her family very much and enjoyed spending time with her sisters, and with her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. She loved the outdoors and enjoyed camping in Wisconsin with her family in her later years.

Alice is survived by her sister Opal Falkenrath Lipke of Oklahoma; son Ronnie Wayne Wells and wife Donna of Semmes, Alabama; son Kenneth Gerald Wells and wife Tauni of Sparta, Wisconsin; 16 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and 9 great great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband Clyde Raymond Wells who passed away in 1996; her daughter Carolyn Wells Dieser; infant daughter Alice Elaine Wells; and grandson Timothy Dieser
