Angela Marie "Angie" Gibson, passed away Friday, October 14, 2011, near the community of Sleeper, Missouri in Laclede County, at the age of 37 years, 1 month and 3 days.

One of three children and the only daughter of the union of Frank E. Hall and Anne (Stewart) Hall Cooper, Angie was born September 11, 1974 in Pekin, Illinois.

Angie grew up and attended school in Pekin, before moving to the Laquey, Missouri area where she graduated from Laquey High School, Class of 1992. As a child she enjoyed taking family vacations to Missouri; spending much time at Barlow's Ford River floating and laying in the sun tanning.

For the last six years, Angie worked as a housekeeper for the lodging department on Ft. Leonard Wood. Angie loved watching her son Logan play soccer and listening to her son Billy's music.

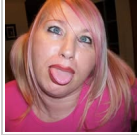
