



## Arthur Thomas Berger

December 6, 1947 - November 26, 2014

Arthur Thomas Berger, son of Thomas Edward and Harriet May (Moore) Berger, was born December 6, 1947 in St. Louis, Missouri. As a young boy, Arthur moved to Waynesville and was raised by Belle and Luther Ousley. He graduated from Waynesville High School.

A.T., as he was known by his family and friends, entered the United States Navy in August 1967 and was discharged in March 1970. He later went to work on Fort Leonard Wood and became a supervisor with EDP in the mess halls and retired after many years of faithful service.

In his spare time, he enjoyed being outdoors while fishing and camping. He also liked to do woodworking and shooting pool. He was a former member of the American Legion.

A.T. passed away Wednesday, November 26, 2014 in the University of Missouri Hospital of Columbia, Missouri having attained the age of 66 years.

A.T. leaves to cherish his memory one daughter: Melissa Jean Nestler of Belleville, IL; two grandchildren: Kyle and Philip; two brothers: Chuck Ousley (Velda) of Waynesville, MO and Lawrence Pratt (DeShay) of Hogan, MO; one cousin: Dick Ousley of Waynesville, MO; several nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
