



## Asako Suzuki Thomason

November 19, 1927 - June 10, 2014

Asako Suzuki Thomason was born November 19, 1927 in Japan where she attended school in Ibaraki-Ken on the Island of Honshu.

On November 21, 1952, Asako was united in marriage to Callie Eugene Thomason in Yokahama, Japan. They shared over 41 years of marriage together before he preceded her in death on February 20, 1994. Asako and Callie were blessed with one daughter: Amy and shared two stepchildren: Jane and Jean.

Due to Callie being in the United States military, Asako came to the United States and gained her citizenship. She and the family moved to several different duty stations and came to the Fort Leonard Wood area where Callie retired.
