Bertha Sue Bott, daughter of the late Robert and Sylvania (Wagers) Sizemore, was born November 11, 1949 in Hyden, Leslie County, Kentucky. She passed away Monday, October 19, 2020 in the Miller County Care and Rehab Center of Tuscumbia, Missouri having attained the age of 70 years, 11 months and 8 days.

As a young girl, Sue, as she was known to her family and friends, attended Felts Elementary School in Corbin, Kentucky and then attended Lily High School in Lily, Kentucky where she graduated.
