Bessie Lartina Jones, daughter of the late Floyd Booker, Sr. and Eleanor (Robinson) Booker, was born July 4, 1954 in Salem, New Jersey. She passed away Friday, October 11, 2019 in the General Leonard Wood Army Community Hospital of Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri having attained the age of 65 years.

At the age of 16, Bessie was united in marriage to a United States soldier by the name of Timothy Jones. They were married in Woodstown, New Jersey and shared the next 48 years together and were blessed with two daughters: LaSandra and Lartina.

Due to Timothy being in the military, Bessie and the family moved to Fort Bragg, North Carolina for a time until 1975 when they were transferred to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. Timothy decided to retire in the Waynesville / St. Robert area where they raised their family.

Most of Bessie's working years were spent working on Fort Leonard Wood as 1st Cook for EDP Enterprises and retired after over 25 years of faithful service at the same time maintaining the home and caring for her family and their needs.
