Beverly Ruth Elliott, daughter of the late Thomas Ray and Frieda Elinore (Campbell) York, was born June 4, 1939 in Bloodland, Missouri. She passed away Sunday morning, July 26, 2015 in the Lake Regional Hospital of Osage Beach, Missouri having attained the age of 76 years.
