



## Billy Edward Jones

January 17, 1945 - October 7, 2010

Billy Edward Jones, son of Loren Jones and Frances (Coryell) Jones Scott, was born on January 17, 1945 in Lebanon, Missouri where he grew up and attended school.

Billy enlisted in the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his honorable discharge in 1969. He served in Vietnam and earned several awards and commendations; some of which included: National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Combat Infantry Badge, Vietnam Campaign Medal w/60 device, 2 Overseas Service Bars, Sharpshooter (Rifle) and Sharpshooter (Machine Gun).

On August 31, 1991, Billy was united in marriage to Dana I. McKinnon in Miami, Oklahoma. They shared over 19 years of marriage together and many wonderful memories.

After leaving the service, Billy began working in the coal mines in Kansas and eventually moved back home to Lebanon and began driving a truck for several different companies until 1996. At that time, Billy began helping Dana in her upholstery business and in 1999, Billy became 100% disabled.

When he was able, Billy enjoyed being outdoors while hunting and fishing. He spent a lot of time reading and loved reading anything he could get his hands

on. He was a member of the VFW and the American Legion posts in Lebanon. Most importantly, he treasured those times spent with his family and friends.

Billy passed away at 12:12 P.M. Thursday, October 7, 2010 in the Osage Beach Health Care Center of Osage Beach, Missouri at the age of 65, 8 months and 21 days. He will be sadly missed but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.
