Brandon James Figg, son of James “Jim” Richard Figg and Mary Frances (Puckett) Figg, was born April 23, 1988 in Rolla, Missouri. He passed away Saturday, October 27, 2018 in the Citizens Memorial Hospital of Bolivar, Missouri having attained the age of thirty.

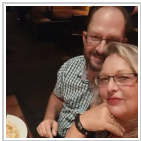

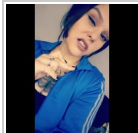
