Brigid Parker, daughter of the late Robert Kavanagh and Anne (Foley) Kavanagh, was born November 10, 1933, in County Wexford, Ireland.

In 1952, Brigid moved to London, England and met a young United States soldier by the name of Thomas John Parker. They were united in marriage on February 23, 1962, in Kingston, New York and shared over 53 years of marriage together and were blessed with four children: Suzanne, Patricia, Thomas, and Michael. Thomas preceded Brigid in death on May 24, 2015.

Due to Thomas being in the military, the family was transferred to the Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri area where they decided to remain after Thomas retired from the military.

Brigid raised her four children here and she loved being a mother and later a grandmother. She loved her family dearly and treasured all the time that they could spend together.

In her spare time, Brigid enjoyed taking walks and reading. She was a member of the St. Robert Bellarmine Catholic Church until she and Thomas moved to Lebanon, Missouri and then became a member of the St. Francis de Sales Parish.
