



Brittany Ann and Infant Cadence Jay Coffelt

April 7, 1991 - May 14, 2010

Brittany Ann Coffelt, 19, and her infant son, Cadence Jay Coffelt, passed away at 8:45 a.m., Friday, May 14, at St. John's Breech Hospital, Lebanon, Missouri, as the result of injuries sustained in a two vehicle accident on Hwy 133 near Richland, Missouri.

Vicki (Wessel) and Keith Evan Burkhart welcomed their second daughter, Brittany Ann, into the world on April 7, 1991, in Newark, Ohio. Brittany grew up in Clarksville, Tennessee, and moved to Richland, Missouri, at the age of 12.

Upon the Burkhart family's arrival to Pulaski County, they began attending Harmony Baptist Church. Shortly thereafter, Brittany received Jesus Christ as her personal Savior and pledged her membership.

On November 17, 2009 in Waynesville, Missouri, Brittany was united in marriage with Jonathan Patrick Coffelt. Brittany and Jon were expecting the arrival of their son, Cadence Jay Coffelt in July.

Brittany was currently attending the Rolla, Missouri Technical Center enrolled in the Respiratory Therapy program. She was employed at Subway in Waynesville, and previously at Stockstill's Pharmacy in Richland.

Brittany was blessed with many gifts. She had a great talent for music, and enjoyed singing and playing the acoustic and bass guitars. She was fun-loving and full of life, and will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved her.

Funeral services were held at 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, May 18, 2010 in the Harmony Baptist Church of Waynesville with Bro. Dwain Carter officiating. 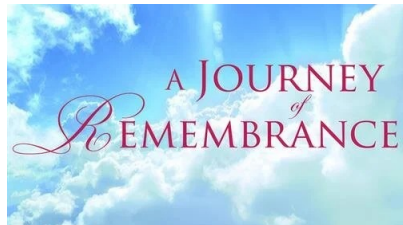

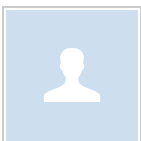
