Burgett "Bud" Huston Watts, son of the late Oscar F. and Fannie Zoe (Beers) Watts, was born February 29, 1928 in Courtois, Missouri.

Bud entered the United States Army and served his country faithfully from 1950 - 1952 until his honorable discharge. He had attained the rank of Private 2.

Bud worked as a construction worker and for nine years drove a dump truck for the City of St. Robert after moving to the Waynesville / St. Robert area.

On June 20, 1995, Bud was united in marriage to Nancy Mae Miller in Gunnison, Colorado. They shared over 21 years of marriage together and many wonderful memories.

In his spare time, Bud enjoyed being outdoors while hunting and also loved to travel.

When Bud's health permitted, he attended the First Christian Church of Waynesville.

Bud passed away Thursday, December 22, 2016 in the Rock Spring Residential Care Center of Cuba, Missouri having attained the age of 88

years, 9 months and 22 days.

In addition to his parents, Bud was preceded in death by one brother: Haskel Watts.
