Calvin Max Sisco, was born on February 13, 1950 to the late Oren Max and Mary L. (Deckard) Sisco in Springfield, Missouri. Calvin departed this life at 4:55 a.m. Sunday, June 26, 2011, at his home. He had attained the age of 61 years, 4 months, and 13 days.

Calvin grew up in the Springfield and surrounding area. He graduated from Parkview High School. Calvin obtained a Criminal Science Degree from Drury University in Springfield, Missouri. Calvin had three children: Cynthia, Devin, and Jennifer. On November 16, 2004 Calvin was united in marriage with Linda Louise Randleman in Kirbyville, Missouri. They shared over 6 years together.

Calvin attained the rank of E-4 while serving as a military policeman in the United States Army. He faithfully served his country in Korea during the Vietnam War. After leaving the military, Calvin served as a police officer in the Springfield Police Department in Springfield, Missouri. He proudly served the Springfield area for 25 years.

Calvin enjoyed fishing, hunting, and bowling. He rescued any dog breed he could. Calvin also played lead guitar in the Queen City Heat Band. He loved to make people laugh and had a special talent for it. Calvin was a member of the Elks Lodge.

Calvin is survived by his wife: Louise Sisco of the home; three children: Cynthia Ferrell (Steve) of Ft. Polk, LA, Devin Sisco of Rogersville, MO and Jennifer Blankenship of Willard, MO; two stepchildren: Jeff Randleman (Heather) of Mt.
