After a time, the family was transferred to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri where she began working as a room attendant on base. She worked for over 18 years with two different companies and was one of the hardest working employees.

On December 2, 2010, Carmen was united in marriage to Manny Rodriguez in Hinesville, Georgia. They shared over six years of marriage together and many wonderful memories.

Carmen was a very kind, but outspoken person. She was always willing to take the time to answer any question or solve any problem no matter how big or how small and would be completely honest with you in a loving way. She had a huge and forgiving heart.

She enjoyed the simple things in life and one of those was working in her flower and vegetable gardens with her husband, Manny. She had a passion for reading, especially James Patterson books. But her greatest joy came from spending time with her family, especially the grandchildren.
