Charles Edward English, son of the late Palmer English and Clairsie Lavonia (Pettis) English, was born August 1, 1947 in Palatka, Florida. As a young boy, Charles grew up in Green Cove Springs, Florida and graduated from Clay High School.

Shortly after graduating from high school, Charles entered the United States Army and served his country for 17 years. For his faithful service to the military, he attained the rank of Staff Sergeant and earned several awards and commendations; some of which include: National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal w/1 Bronze Service Star, Overseas Service Ribbon (1), Good Conduct Medal (4th Award), National Cross of Gallantry w/Palm (Unit), Non Professional Development Ribbon (3), Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Vietnam Service Medal w/1 Silver Service Star, Armed Services Ribbon, Expert Qualification Badge M-16, and Vietnam Cross of Gallantry w/Palm.

After his honorable discharge from the military, Charles continued serving his country as a civil service employee teaching warrant officers advanced course for wheeled vehicle technician. He served in this capacity for 20+ years before retiring.

On April 15, 2006, Charles was united in marriage to April Michelle Juergens

in Osage Beach, Missouri. They shared over 16 years of marriage together and many wonderful memories. At the time of their union, two families were joined and together they shared five children: Tommy, Glen, Ryan, Mikayla, and Adyson.

In his spare time, Charles enjoyed being outdoors while fishing and camping. He also loved to ride his motorcycle and just enjoying nature while riding. Charles was a member of the Masonic Lodge, Shrine Club, and Widow's Sons.

Most importantly, he treasured spending time with his family and friends and looked forward to times they could spend together.

Charles passed away Sunday, July 17, 2022 in the Harry S. Truman Medical Center of Columbia, Missouri having attained the age of 74 years. He will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.

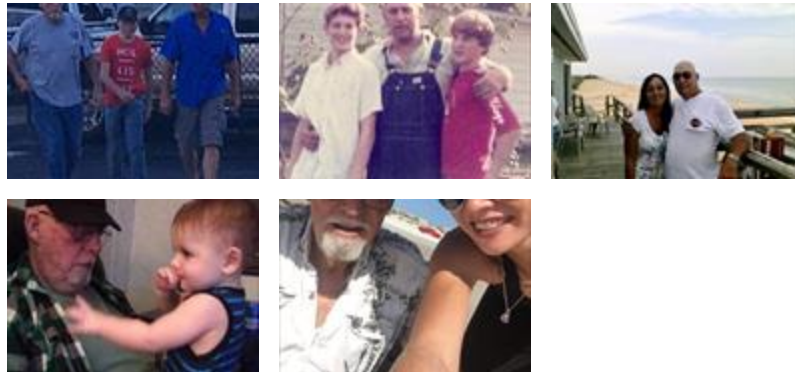

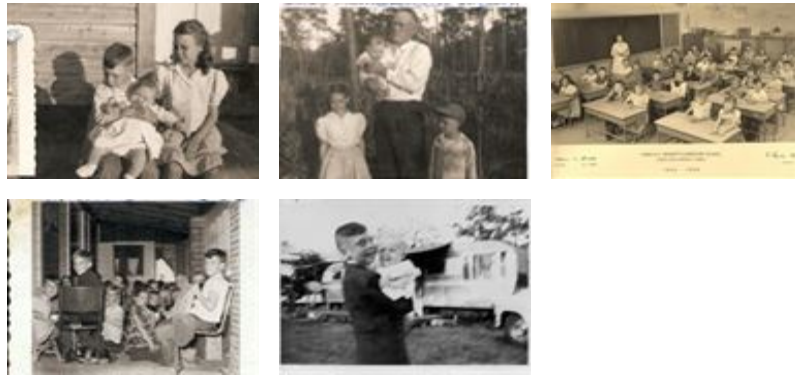
