Charles Ira Fairchild, 58, passed away on Saturday, October 12, 2024. A visitation was held from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. on Friday, October 18, 2024 at the Bayview Freeborn Funeral Home in Albert Lea, Minnesota.

Charles was born in Des Plaines, Illinois on January 19th, 1966 to Harold and Nancy (Towell) Fairchild. Before graduating from High School, he enrolled in the Army and served for 7 ½ years before being honorably discharged. He worked at H.D. Lee in several positions for 5 years.
