Charles Warren "Chuckie" Fairchild, son of Charles Ira and Annette Suelynn (Clark) Fairchild, was born March 14, 1987 in Ft. Sill, Oklahoma. At the age of 5 months old, Chuckie and the family moved to the Fort Leonard Wood area. He attended and graduated from Laquey High School.

While still in high school, Chuckie worked at the Buckhorn Bowling Alley for a time before moving to Whidbey Island, Washington with Jessica after graduating from high school. After living in Washington for a few years, he then moved to Grain Valley. Chuckie worked for Comcast for 8 years traveling the country training people and later went to work for Enterprise Rent a Car.

On March 16, 2007, Chuckie was united in marriage to his high school sweetheart, Jessica Lynn Warner. They were blessed with one daughter, Emma Belle. Chuckie was the best dad and husband and his daughter was the apple of his eye.
