



Charles L. "Stacky" Henson

November 17, 1931 - June 22, 2011

Charles Monroe Leona "Stacky" Henson went home to be with his Lord the afternoon of June 22, 2011, at St. John's Medical Center, Springfield, Missouri, at the age of 79 years, 7 months and 5 days.

Charles, or as friends called him "Stacky", was born on November 17, 1931 to Everett B. and Lyndall E. (Chafen) Henson in Richland, Missouri. Charles was raised in a large family. He was the 5th of 19 children.

On April 8, 1950, Charles married the love of his life, Marie E. (Baranowski) Henson. They were united in marriage at J.O. Brown's House in Richland, MO. Charles and Marie shared over 61 years of marriage. The couple shared many memories together. Charles and Marie were blessed with two children: a daughter, Kathy, and a son, Billy.

Charles worked for the Civil Service for most of his career. He worked from August 1950 until January 1982. He worked as a shoe fitter then later became a supervisor of clothing sales. For four years Charles owned and operated the Dairy Queen in Richland. He retired shortly after an open-heart surgery in 1981. Charles enjoyed watching birds; collecting coins, knives, and antiques; dogs; hunting; and just being with family and friends. He built his own home of 56 years with his own hands. Charles attended and was a member of the First Baptist Church, Richland, Missouri. He was baptized in March of 1950 at the

old First Baptist Church of Richland. He was also involved with many organizations such as the Masonic Lodge 385 AF & AM, Shriners, Eastern Star, Park Board Member, volunteer fire fighter for Richland, and Scottish Rites of St. Louis.

He is preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Wanda; one brother, Willard; and four other siblings.
