Charles William Nicks, son of the late William Bryan and Edith Imo (Hendricks) Nicks, was born February 20, 1932 in Laquey, Missouri where he grew up and attended school.

On March 23, 1951, Charles was united in marriage to Catherine (Lane) Bell in Waynesville, Missouri. They shared over 40 years of marriage together and were blessed with three children: Charles, Cathy and James.

Charles served his country faithfully in the United States Army and was awarded several awards and commendations. He was honorably discharged and had attained the rank of Corporal.

For a short period of time, Charles lived in Baton Rouge, Louisiana and was employed as an industrial painter. After leaving Baton Rouge, Charles and his family moved back to the Crocker, Missouri area and he became employed with Goodrich Gas Company driving a truck. He retired in the late 1990's after many years of service.

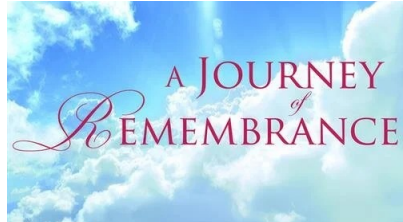
