Charlotte Harbaugh, daughter of Gerram Tuten and Eva Agnes (Smith) Bowers, was born July 23, 1932 in Estill, South Carolina. She went home to be with her Lord on November 19, 2018 in the General Leonard Wood Army Community Hospital of Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri having attained the age of eighty-six years.
