



## Cheryl Lynn (Jacobson) Green

June 13, 1957 - June 26, 2010

Cheryl Lynn Green passed away Saturday morning, June 26, 2010, at her home in Douglasville, Georgia, at the age of 57 years and 13 days.

One of three children born to the union of the late Donald and Virginia (Edwards) Jacobson, Cheryl was born June 13, 1953 in Aurora, Illinois, where she grew up and graduated from high school.

Aurora is also where she married Dalton Danny Green on June 19, 1971. They spent the next 20 years living where the Army sent him. In 1988, they finally settled in Waynesville, Missouri. Dalton preceded her in death on January 30, 2001.
