Chris made a profession of faith as a young girl while attending High Point Baptist Church and was baptized.

On April 6, 2014 in Stoutland, Missouri, Chris married Rex Alexander Morgan. Together they enjoyed life while raising their precious young son, Gage Joseph Ray Morgan, who is the apple of his parents eye. Chris loved being a wife and mother. Her desire was for her son to have a good life, learn all that he could, be confident, brave, and willing to try new things, but most importantly have fun along the way.

Chris loved kids. She had worked in Day Care briefly but then went on to work at Care Facilities and Churches. Chris was currently working as a CNA-Tec. She had a servants heart and was dedicated to lending a helping hand; even when Chris wasn’t working, she always worried about her clients. Chris looked at them as an extension of her own family.

In her spare time Chris enjoyed cooking and watching cooking shows. She was devoted to her family and loved to spoil everyone.

Chris lived a life filled with kindness, purpose, and joy, right until her passing. Her busy day began like many before had. Not feeling her best, Chris powered through her day and headed off to work. Shortly after arriving on the evening of Friday, May 30, 2025, Chris suddenly collapsed and was taken to Lake Regional Health System, Osage Beach, Missouri, where she passed into the arms of her Lord and Savior having obtained the age of thirty-seven years.

Chris will always be remembered for her kindness, sweet smile, humor, infectious laugh, and her resilience in facing the challenges of life. Her legacy of love and compassion continues to light our lives, even as we mourn her absence. Family and friendships were at the center of Chris's world. 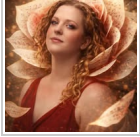

Chrissy wasn’t just my aunt. She was my sister and my best friend. She truly knew me—my heart, my humor, my weird quirks and quiet thoughts. For a few years of my life, I had the gift of being fully understood, because I had her by my side.

We did everything together—riding four-wheelers, laughing in the go-kart Grandpa made, visiting family, feeding the horses (Bambi and Cricket), and going to school and church like sisters. I’ve heard there’s a photo of us at the service today—standing in the snow in our winter coats with matching new haircuts. That photo says it all. We were always side by side. And even now, I still feel that.

Chrissy had a way of making my blindness something we could laugh about together. She’d call me out of the blue and say, “Hey, I saw something and thought, now this is for blind people,” and we’d laugh and talk about it. She never made it weird. She made it ours. She made it light. She made it safe. That’s how deep our bond was—she could tease me in a way that made me feel more seen, not less.

I’ll never forget our movie nights—The Aristocats, Peter Pan, or Bambi to fall asleep. That was her comfort, and now it’s part of how I remember her—softly, sweetly, forever.

Chrissy, I love you. I miss you more than I can explain. As you take your final rest today, know that you are not going alone. I’m with you—not just in miles, but in memory, in laughter, in everything we ever shared.

You’ll always be part of me. Always walking with me. From here to forever.

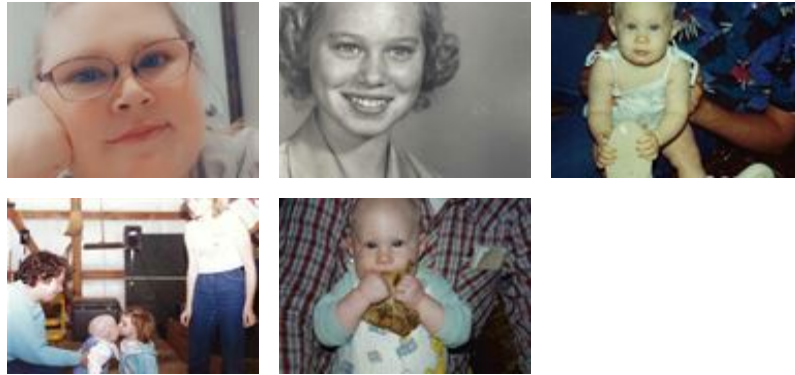
