



## Clarence Edward Bott

December 31, 1925 - July 25, 2017

Clarence Edward Bott, son of the late John Frederick and Fannie Rosetta (Barklow) Bott, was born December 31, 1925 in Freeport, Illinois where he grew up and attended Freeport High School.

In 1942, Clarence enlisted in the United States Navy and served his country faithfully during World War II as a Seabee until his honorable discharge in 1945.

In 1959, Clarence was united in marriage to Darlene Mildred Rump. Darlene preceded him in death in 2016.

After being discharged from the Navy, Clarence began serving an apprenticeship as a carpenter and became a master carpenter. He worked for the union in California, Tennessee and Cedar Hill, Illinois.

In 1994, Clarence and Darlene moved to the St. Robert, Missouri area and remained here until their passing.

Clarence was a member of the Waynesville United Methodist Church and attended every chance he could. He loved his church family and also going to Gospel singings in the area. In his spare time, he enjoyed woodworking, bowling and going to eat at the Waynesville / St. Robert Senior Center where

he enjoyed visiting with his friends.

Clarence passed away Tuesday, July 25, 2017 in the Phelps County Regional Medal Center of Rolla, Missouri having attained the age of 91 years. He will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.

Clarence leaves to cherish his memory, his son: Edward Bott (Sue) of St. Robert, MO; daughter: Linda Nelson (Glen) of Lolita, TX; several grandchildren, great grandchildren, great-great grandchildren, nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

In addition to his parents and wife, Clarence was preceded in death by one son: Charles Bott; one daughter: Diana Bott; and two sisters: Hazel Murphy and Elvira Mellon.

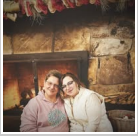
