



Dale Earnest Duncan

February 3, 1931 - May 11, 2013

Dale Earnest Duncan, son of the late John and Stella (Dean) Duncan, was born February 3, 1931 in Spring Creek, Missouri where he grew up and attended a one room school house. He graduated from Newburg High School and furthered his education by obtaining his welding and teaching certificates.

On November 26, 1955, Dale was united in marriage to Dorothy Ann Prewett in Waynesville, Missouri. They shared over 57 years of marriage together and were blessed with two children: Cindy and Dale, Jr.

Dale served his country by serving in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict and later by serving in the United States Marine Corp. He was honorably discharged in 1953.

Dale was a hardworking man. He worked for a several years as a heavy equipment operator and then was able to open his own welding shop. He also taught welding for the Waynesville R-VI School District at the Waynesville Career Center until he became disabled.

In his spare time, Dale enjoyed being outdoors while fishing and hunting. He supplied fish for the annual fish fry at the Shrine Club for several years. He looked forward to that event and he and Dorothy would start early catching fish so they would be sure to have enough for everyone. In his younger years,

Dale drove a race car at the local race tracks...car #11.

Dale was a member of the Waynesville Masonic Lodge #375 AF & AM, the Scottish Rite of Joplin and the Abou Ben Adhem Shrine of Springfield.

Dale passed away Saturday, May 11, 2013 in the Harry S Truman Memorial Veterans Hospital of Columbia, Missouri having attained the age of 82 years, 3 months and 8 days. He will be sadly missed but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.

Dale leaves to cherish his memory his wife, Dorothy Duncan of the home; two children: Cindy Duncan of Crocker, MO and Dale Duncan (JoAnna) of Arnold, MO; five grandchildren: Olivia, Tyler, Hannah, Paige and Christopher Duncan; one great grandchild: Brittney Duncan; several nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

In addition to his parents, Dale was preceded in death by eight brothers: James, Lawrence, Leo, Dean, Walter, Kenneth, John and Chester.

Masonic Services were held at 1:30 p.m. Friday, May 17, 2013 in the Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert. Services were provided by the Waynesville Masonic Lodge #375 AF & AM.

Graveside services with military honors followed at 2:00 p.m. in the Missouri Veterans Cemetery – Fort Leonard Wood with Rev. Curtis Hendrix officiating.
