SFC (Ret) David Lee Christianson, son of the late Palmer Alvin Christianson and Evelyn Dora (Whaly) Hegland, was born October 9, 1938 in Ames, Iowa where he grew up and attended school.

David entered the United States Army shortly after high school and served his country faithfully from 1960 until his retirement in 1981. He served during the Vietnam War, earned several awards and commendations and attained the rank of Sergeant First Class.
