Debra Lynn Lofton, daughter of the late Ralph Walter and Frances Lorraine (Baumgaertel) Lofton, was born May 8, 1955 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. Debra grew up in the Waynesville area and graduated from Waynesville High School.

Debra was united in marriage to Willie New and they were blessed with one daughter, Michelle Cherí. Michelle preceded her in death.

Debra worked at the Post Chaplain's Office for several years before being transferred to DPW where she was currently employed. She was awarded for supporting the Fort Leonard Wood A.S.I.S.T. Program, a suicide prevention program.

Debra was a member of the St. Robert Bellarmine Catholic Church. She dedicated her life to her family and to Bible study. She loved her family and her Lord deeply. She went home to be with her Lord Monday, March 20, 2017 in her home having attained the age of 61 years.

Debra will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved her. She leaves to cherish her memory, her three siblings: Sherry Barnes of St. Robert, MO, Ronald Lofton (Isabelle) of Littleton, CO and Ralph Lofton of Kingston, TN; two nieces: Meagan Condon (Steve) of Gladstone,
