March 19, 1949 - August 29, 2012

Donald R. Grosvenor, son of the late Henry "Harold" and Ildean "Dean" (Seaton) Grosvenor, was born March 19, 1949 in Iberia, Missouri. He passed away Wednesday, August 29, 2012 in his home having attained the age of 63 years, 5 months and 10 days.

Don grew up around St. Anthony, Missouri on the family farm. Don and the family moved to the Waynesville area in 1960 and he graduated from Waynesville High School in 1967. Shortly after graduation, Don joined the United States Navy.

Don served his country from July 1967 to November 1973. He attained the rank of ETN2 and was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, Meritorious Unit Commendation (2), Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal and the National Defense Service Medal.

In January 1974, Don began working for Xerox as a service technician and stayed there until his retirement in February 2010. In his spare time, he enjoyed keeping cattle on the farm, deer hunting and fishing. He loved being outdoors. He was a lifetime member of the Francis J. Lynch VFW Post 3168 of Laquey. Don also enjoyed those times spent with his family and friends, especially the grandkids.

Don will be sadly missed by all those that knew and loved him. Even though he is gone from us, he will be forever in our hearts. He leaves to cherish his memory two sons: David Grosvenor of Waynesville and Daniel Grosvenor of St. Louis, MO; one brother: Doug Grosvenor (Peggy) of Laquey, MO; one sister: Susan Grosvenor of St. Robert, MO; four grandchildren: Katrina, Damon, Dominique and Annabella; several nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

In addition to his parents, Don was preceded in death by one brother, Terry Grosvenor.

Memorial services were held at 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, September 4, 2012 in the Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert with Rev. Richard Breeden officiating. The songs "In the Garden" and "How Great thou Art" were played.

Interment with military honors followed in the Missouri Veterans Cemetery – Fort Leonard Wood. Honors were provided by the Missouri Honors Team.
