SFC Edilberto “Ed” Mate Anover, Jr., son of Edilberto Mate Anover, Sr., and Rosemarie Theresa Arandain, was born December 29, 1961, in Honolulu, Hawaii.

Due to his father being in the Navy, Ed grew up well-traveled, but because he spent the majority of his early years in Hawaii, he claimed Hawaii as his home. The family then settled in California where Ed graduated from high school and college.

While in California, Ed worked for Jim Bean Corporation for 10 years before he enlisted in the United States Army. He had served in the Army for 25 years, of which the last 4 years have been at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri; Ed had attained the rank of Sergeant First Class. For his faithful service, Ed earned several awards and commendations.

On February 12, 2016, Ed was united in marriage to Veronica Ann Byrd in St. Louis, Missouri.

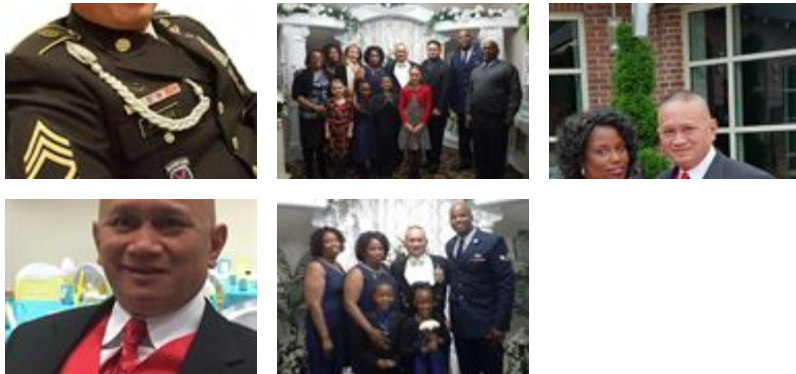
