



## Edward Bruington

December 16, 1921 - March 19, 2012

Edward Bruington was born December 16, 1921 in Charleston, South Carolina, the youngest of five children born to Isaiah and Harriette (Brown) Bruington. Mr. Edward Bruington leaves to mourn his son, Edward Tyrone Bruington, one son-in-law Kenneth Hill; one daughter-in-law Sylvester Bruington, grandchildren Jennifer Dickstein, Erica Bruington, Cassandra V. Thompson (Leshawd), Janai McCallum (Charles), Janniece Green, and Sandra Hill, eight grandchildren and a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.

In 1942, Mr. Bruington joined the US Navy and served until March 1946. He was proud of his military service and later became a lifetime member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) in Queens, New York. He was a member of the COL Edward O. Gourdin, New York, VFW Post 5298.

He was an active member of Metropolitan A.M.E. Church in New York City, New York where he served on the Usher Board and was a member of the Adult Gospel Choir. He attended church there as long as he was healthy. When his health failed and he was unable to live by himself he was moved to Waynesville, Missouri to reside with his son and daughter-in-law. Despite his health issues he enjoyed going to church. He was faithful in going to church with his family when he was physically able.

Funeral services were held at 3:00 p.m. Sunday, March 25, 2012 in the

Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert with Pastor John R. Fuller officiating. James McAllister and Valerie Harris provided the music. Eric Jackson and Mother Nina Carr read Scripture from the Old and New Testament and Cassandra Thompson, granddaughter of Edward, read the obituary. Sister Gbarra Fuller and Mrs. Emma Gill read tributes and reflections.

Burial with military honors was held at 1:00 p.m. Monday, March 26, 2012 in the Missouri Veterans Cemetery – Fort Leonard Wood. Serving as escorts were SFC Paul Sanford, SFC Wayne Brooks, Mr. Nathan Henderson, Mr. Eric Jackson, Mr. Tim Collier and LeShawd Thompson. Military honors were provided by the United States Navy.
