Edward John Lesio passed away at 4:45 p.m. September 9, 2009 at his home near Dixon, Missouri, at the age of 77 years, 11 months and 12 days.

Edward was born September 28, 1931 in Rochester, New York. He was one of six children born to the union of the late Genaro and Julia (D'Andre) Lesio. Edward was raised in the Catholic faith. He was baptized and confirmed in Rochester.

Edward grew up and attended school in Rochester and New York City. He was a Korean War veteran, serving his country in the U.S. Air Force from 1950 to 1960. He received his honorable discharge having attained the rank of Staff Sergeant.

After his military service, Edward made his home in the Boise and Lewiston, Idaho areas, where he owned and operated a dental lab and served as its ceramist.

In 1985, Edward moved to the Pulaski County, Missouri area. On April 16, 1995, he married Donna J. Teem in Laquey, Missouri. He and Donna made their home near Dixon.

Edward retired from civil service with the Harper Dental Clinic at Ft. Leonard

Wood. He also owned and operated the Crown and Bridge Dental Clinic in Dixon.

Edward loved sports, especially golf, baseball, football and basketball. He was a member of the Francis J. Lynch Memorial VFW Post 3168, Laquey.
