Eric Angelo Nikitas, son of Angelo Nikitas and Debra Lynn (Johnson) Nikitas, was born April 4, 1987, in Fort Bliss, Texas and entered his eternal home on Wednesday, February 5, 2025, in the University of Missouri Hospital of Columbia, Missouri having attained the age of 37 years.
