



Evelyn Maxine Foote Davis

July 21, 1935 - February 21, 2024

Evelyn Maxine Davis was born in Waynesville, Missouri on July 21, 1935 to Paul Leslie Foote and Erdis Iro (Decker) Foote. She entered into the presence of God with her loving children by her side, the morning of Wednesday, February 21, 2024, having attained the age of 88, in Springfield, Missouri.

She gave her life to Christ on July 7, 1946 and became a member of the Pleasant Grove Christian Church and was baptized in the Gasconade River on Highway 35 which is now Highway 7. She later moved her membership to the Richland Christian Church in 1957.

She attended grade school at Caves Springs near Hanna, and Pleasant Grove near Buckhorn and graduated from Richland High School in the class of 1952. Evelyn then went to work at the International Shoe Factory and worked for four years until she met the love of her life and was united in marriage to Clifford Leo Davis on June 2, 1956. They shared 50 years, 6 months, and 13 days of marriage until his death on December 15, 2006. To this union was born three children, Janet Kay, Julia Ann, and Clifford Leo Jr.

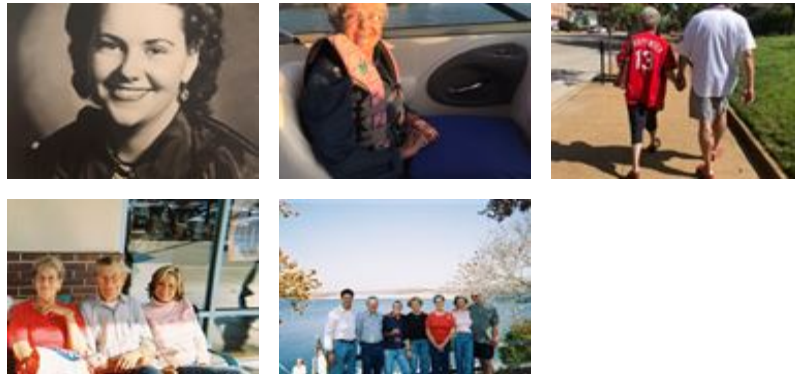
