



Francis Dwight Boren

August 28, 1944 - November 7, 2024

Francis Dwight Boren, son of the late Frank William Boren and Alpha Marie (Hancock) Boren, was born in Hawkeye, Missouri on August 28, 1944.

Dwight, as he was known by his family and friends, grew up in Hawkeye where he attended elementary school and transferred to Richland High School.

In 1968, Dwight entered the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his honorable discharge. He served during the Vietnam War, earned the rank of Sergeant, and was very proud of being able to serve his country. He earned several awards and commendations; some of which include National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal w/3 Bronze Service Stars, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Combat Infantryman Badge, Expert (Rifle), 2 CL Grenade (N-60 MG), Vietnamese Gallantry Cross w/Palm, Bronze Star Medal, U.S. Air Medal. He became a member of the Army National Guard after his honorable discharge from active duty.

Dwight began working for Amonia Refrigeration Systems as a maintenance mechanic. He took great pride in his work and enjoyed helping people.

On July 14, 2004, Dwight was united in marriage to Patsy Ann Leach in Las Vegas, Nevada. They shared over 20 years of marriage together and at the

time of their union, two families were joined to include children: Michelle, Tammy, Brenda, Regina, Chris, Christy, Brandon, Timothy, and Marcy.

In his spare time, Dwight loved riding his tractor, keeping the lawn fresh and feeding the deer behind his house and watching them from his window.

Dwight had made a profession of faith earlier in his life and he was a member of Mt. Gilead Church. He loved attending church and serving people as a deacon for the church.

Dwight entered his heavenly home on Thursday, November 7, 2024, in his home having attained the age of 80 years. He will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.

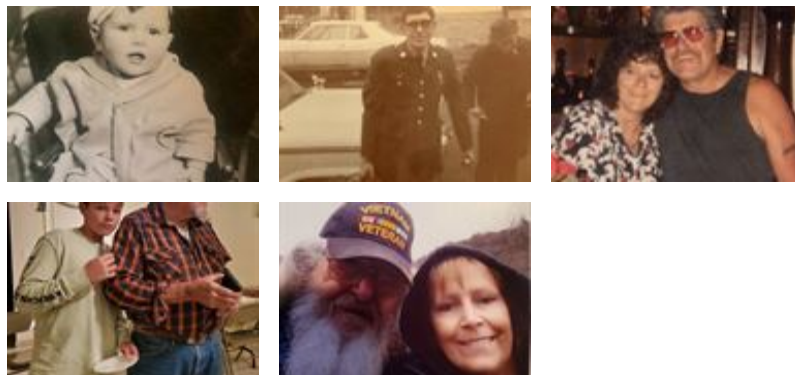
