



Fusako "Katie" Koyasu Mahoney

January 18, 1924 - January 28, 2026

Fusako "Katie" Mahoney, the daughter of Isenosuke Koyasu and Shino (Ueda) Koyasu, was born on January 18, 1924, in Taiwan. Katie spent her childhood in Taiwan, where she attended school and grew up surrounded by family.

Katie later moved to Japan, where she met Walter Michael Mahoney, a young United States soldier. The couple married on September 10, 1952, in Chiba, Japan, and welcomed their daughter, Patricia. Walter preceded Katie in death on July 30, 2003.

Due to Walter being in the military, Katie came to the United States. After they relocated to the Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri area, Katie established and operated her own business, Katie's Snack Bar, for several years.

Following Walter's passing, Katie moved to St. Louis to be closer to her daughter. She passed away on Wednesday, January 28, 2026, at Nazareth Living Center in St. Louis, Missouri, at the age of 102.

Katie will be missed and fondly remembered by those who knew and loved her. She is survived by her daughter, Patricia Mahoney of St. Louis, Missouri, as well as many family members in Japan.

Graveside services will be held at a later date, managed by Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville/St. Robert.
