George Allen III was born on August 9, 1980, in Lebanon, Missouri, to George Elvin Allen, Jr. and Angelika Mina (Trippett) Allen. As a young teenager, he accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior and was baptized at Westside Baptist Church of Waynesville, Missouri.

Known affectionately as "Georgie" by his family and friends, he grew up in Waynesville. He graduated from Waynesville High School with the Class of 1998. Georgie later attended Three Rivers Community College, where he played baseball and continued his education.

After returning to Waynesville, Georgie married and was blessed with a daughter. He cherished every moment he spent with her, holding her close to his heart.

Georgie worked for several years at Fort Leonard Wood for MWR. He then spent over twenty years at Lowe Chevrolet. Following his tenure there, he worked at Graven Chevrolet in Lebanon before transitioning to construction and joining Blackstone Consulting.

In his spare time, Georgie enjoyed spending time outdoors, particularly fishing and turkey hunting. In his younger years, he loved bowling and participating in various sports, with baseball being his main passion. He was proud to play for

On Wednesday, March 25, 2026, Georgie passed away at St. Louis University Hospital at the age of 45.
