Giles "Scotty" Leon Ogle, son of James and Myrtle (Stewart) Ogle, was born September 19, 1942 in Lebanon, Missouri. He went home to be with his Lord at 9:28 a.m. November 1, 2013 in his home having attained the age of 71 years.

Scotty attended elementary school in Richland and graduated from Richland High School. He later attended two years of college at Missouri Valley College and was majoring in counseling.
