Hannelore Caulk, daughter of Edmund Scheu and Otilia Abbzecht, was born January 30, 1956 in Essenhein, Germany where she grew up and attended school. She attended vocational school in Mainz, Germany.

On September 28, 1973, Hannelore was united in marriage to Marvin George Caulk, a United States Army soldier who she met while he was stationed in Germany. They were married in Nieder Olm, Germany and shortly after their marriage they were transferred to the United States.

While still in Germany, Hannelore worked at a bakery and a department store. Hannelore obtained her CNA license and after coming to the United States and being transferred to the Fort Leonard Wood area, Hannelore worked as a CNA at Balance Care in Dixon and then at Life Care Center in Waynesville.

In her spare time, Hannelore loved to read and watch movies. She was an avid animal lover and would take on about any stray dog or cat that she came across. Most importantly, she loved spending time with her family and friends.
