Harold David Maddox, son of the late Howard Harvey Maddox, Sr., and Rosetta May (Salter) Maddox, was born June 19, 1947 in Waynesville, Missouri, where he grew up and attended school, graduating from Waynesville High School.

“Dave,” as he was known by, later moved to St. Louis, Missouri where he lived and worked at a furniture store as a salesman for almost 20 years before moving in to the small community of Richland.
