On February 7, 1938, Harvey Ellis Jones was born to David and Margaret Jones in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He grew up in the hustle and bustle of Milwaukee. He was raised in the Catholic Church and was all boy as a child.

He enlisted in the United States Army and retired in 1984 as a First Sergeant. He was proud of his military career.

In 1977, he met Laura, his country girl. In June of 1978, they were married and lived in Laquey the rest of his life. His first month of marriage, he couldn't sleep because it was too quiet in the country.

After retirement, Harvey worked as a school bus driver for six months and then went to work with Civil Service in Phase I & Phase II clothing issue. He enjoyed his job and co-workers.

Harvey's combined family with Laura included six children: Nancy, Harvey Jr., Michelle, John, Anthony, and Joseph.

Harvey enjoyed fishing on the Gasconade River. Often on weekends, he would load up his pickup with supplies and kids: his children, nieces, nephews and their friends. After the children grew up he went fishing with his grandkids. His six children were the jewels of his life. He loved cooking for family get

togethers.

Harvey passed away Monday, April 23, 2018 having attained the age of 80 years. He is lovingly missed by his family and friends.

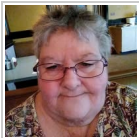

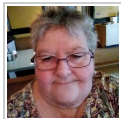
