Helga Louisa Isner, daughter of the late Michael and Louisa Riedner, on September 30, 1937 in Wurzburg, Germany and passed away on September 22, 2018 in Springfield, Missouri surrounded by family having attained the age of eighty years.

Helga grew up in Germany where she attended school and met a handsome young United States soldier by the name of Harry "Ike" Hobert Isner. They were united in marriage and blessed with four children, Susie, Peggy, Anita and Harry, Jr.

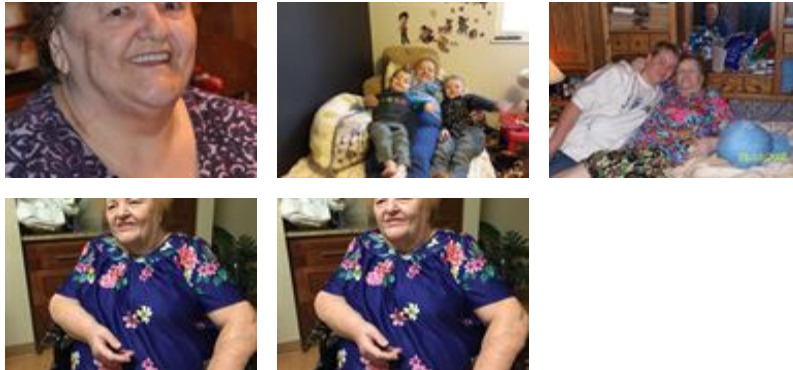

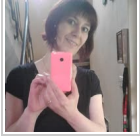
