



## Hugh James "Jim" Glackin

April 23, 1942 - May 13, 2011

Hugh James "Jim" Glackin, son of the late Hugh Leonard Glackin and Mary Ellen Armenta Glackin, was born April 23, 1942 in Kansas City, Missouri.

As a young boy, Jim and his family moved to the Richland, Missouri area where he grew up and attended school. He moved back to Kansas City in 1958 where he continued his education. While there he met and was united in marriage to Sandra Kay McDaniel on May 2nd 1959. Jim and Sandy shared 36 years of marriage together with many wonderful memories. Sandy preceded Jim in death in 1995.

Jim was employed by Cummins Diesel in Kansas City for twenty-two years. After retiring he moved back to the Richland area where he tried his hand at raising cattle and pigs before turning his efforts toward building a successful backhoe service. Jim operated this business for 20 years before fully retiring in 1999.

In his spare time, Jim enjoyed being outdoors whether riding his motorcycle, his four-wheeler or just sitting on the porch. He loved being on the water and through the years one could find Jim swimming, SCUBA diving, boating, camping or riding a jet ski.

As a child Jim attended Elm Grove Baptist Church of Richland.

Jim passed away Friday, May 13, 2011 at his home outside of Richland at the age of 69 years. He will be sadly missed by all those that knew and loved him.
