James "Jim" Richard Figg, age 73, of Pittsburg, Missouri, passed away on Thursday, July 18, 2024, at his home with his family by his side.

Jim was born on February 2, 1951, in Hale, Missouri, to the late Richard "Dick" and Marion Jean (Searcy) Figg. Jim was united in marriage to the love of his life, Jonnie Leuthen, on October 16, 2009.

Jim was a very active man, always keeping busy. He enjoyed bass and crappie fishing, competing in numerous tournaments, he loved to play pool, he was a member of a bowling league, bowling at least three nights a week in the winter months. Spring and summertime brought Jim to many golf courses, playing many times throughout the week. He was the founder of Play Fore Pink, a charity golf tournament to benefit the Carrie J. 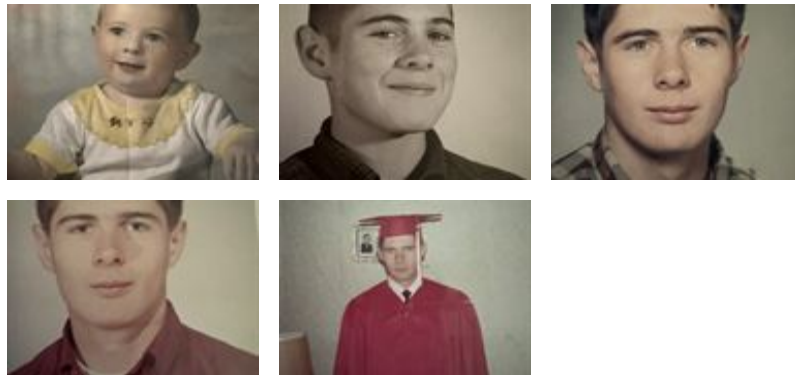
