Jaunita Mae Langston, 88, went home to be with her Lord Wednesday, August 17, 2016 in her daughter's home in Zephyrhills, Florida. 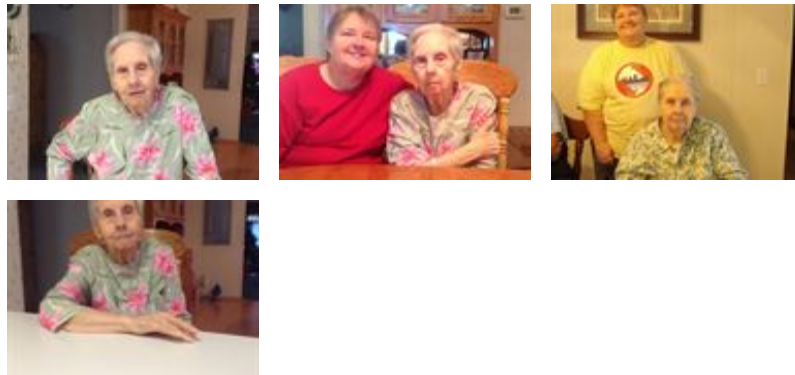
