Jeffrey loved to eat and became a skillful and creative cook.

Jeffrey's family always prayed that he would find the love of a woman who was deserving of his incredibly strong, loving heart. Their prayers were answered when he met Toni Brown. Although their time together was not nearly long enough, he felt it and proclaimed his love and gratitude for her to those close to him.

Jeffry passed away Thursday, January 3, 2019 in his home in Richland, Missouri having attained the age of thirty-six years. He will be sadly missed but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.

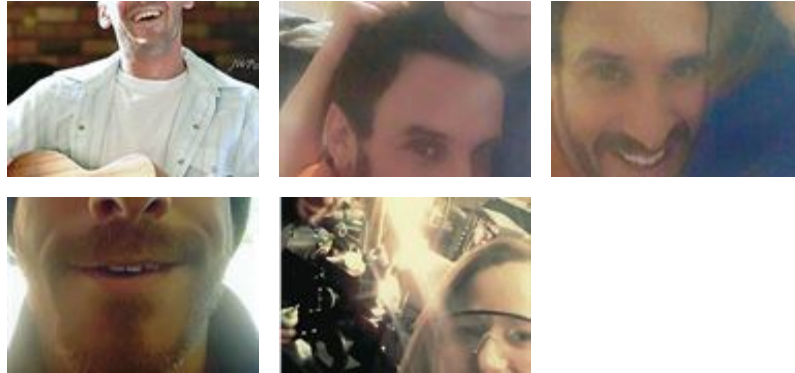

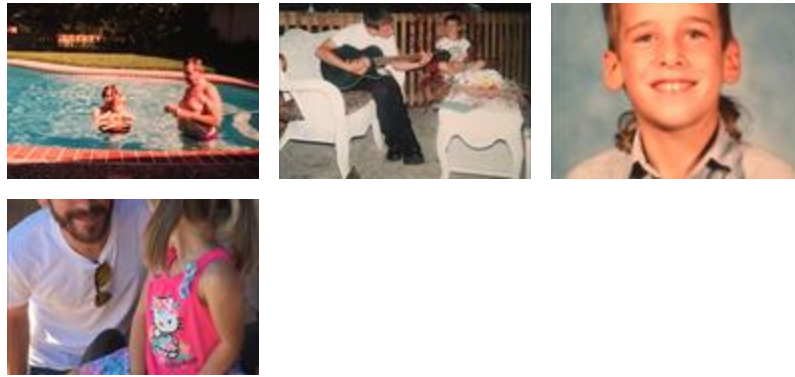
